Questionnaire must be received by Sunday, February 3, 2008, either in the mail or at the meeting. Send your formal stage questionnaire to John Pappas, separately, as addressed on the other questionnaire.

An entertainment meeting (formal and informal) will be held. Date and place to be determined. This meeting helps make the program run smoothly and will help make your performance the pride of the festival. If you cannot attend, please send a representative.

Two (2) identical tapes or CDs should be made by your group/organization and brought by a responsible member to your informal performance and given to the soundman 30 minutes before your scheduled performance time. Please take your tape or CD back after each performance. The media, especially tape, should be a high quality media, and clean, without anything else recorded on it. Multiple numbers on the tape should have a slight pause between each number.

Please make yourself a copy of this completed application.

The performances will probably start about 7:00 P.M. on Friday night, Saturday around 1:00 P.M., ending at 8:00 P.M., and Sunday from 1:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M.

Remember, your time selection is on a first-come, first-serve basis, among other variables.
